Richfield park recognized as officially historic

Richfield Heritage Preserve has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places as "The Crowell Hilaka Historic District.

Several eras of history are represented at the park, but when the Ohio History Connection was first approached about placing it on the register, they decided that the period of significance

was 1937-1969 – the time it served as a Girl Scout camp where thousands of girls and young women ventured into a world frequently described as "magic."

The listing doesn't affect the park's name or its marketing, but it does certify the site as officially historic and bestows valuable recognition.

Summit County Clerk of Courts announces resumption of suspended services

Summit County Clerk of Courts Sandra Kurt announced that on Tuesday, May 26, 2020, the Clerk's office reopened two of its four Title and Passport Division branch locations to visitors and is making operational adjustments to services in the Legal Division. Services were initially restricted on March 16, 2020 in accordance with public health guidelines in response to COVID-19.

The Main Branch office at 1030 East Tallmadge Ave, Akron, and the North

Branch office at 10333 Northfield Rd, Northfield Village, are set to reopen on May 26.

All motor vehicle and watercraft title processing services will resume.

U.S. passport application acceptance and BCI and FBI electronic fingerprint background check will resume on an appointment only basis.
