Many favorite contests are returning along with some fun new ones, which will be revealed at a later time. As in years past there will be lots of great raffle prizes donated by local businesses and individuals.

Several special, \$275 sponsorship opportunities are available such as beverage cart, keg stop, and golfer gift. Also available are unlimited individual hole sponsorships, at various monetary levels in \$100 increments. Also offered is the exclusive sponsorship which provides the donor exclusive rights to a particular hole along with an opportunity to set up a table at that hole with a representative promoting their business and sharing their company swag.

Volunteers are needed to help with

the various contests and to drive the beverage cart on June 14. No job requires prior experience but does promise a lot of fun. Work shifts are from 1-3 p.m. or 3-5 p.m.

Registration and sponsorship forms are included with this newsletter. As previously reported, because of a golf cart shortage, the number of golfers must be limited to 80. Registrations will be taken on a first-come basis so early sign up is suggested.

A \$5 per person late fee will be assessed after the June 1 registration deadline.

A portion of the event proceeds will fund Chamber scholarships for graduating seniors living within the Revere School District. Over \$100,000 has been awarded since its inception. This year, based on the financial results from last year's outing, three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded.
